# Bismuth

The ban on the use of cartridges containing lead shot is being extended to many areas.

Does it affect you and your hunting area?

If you wish to continue using your trusty shotgun, that is no longer compatible with steel shot and remain legal,



an effective solution is the use of **Bismuth**.

Bismuth has a 25% higher specific gravity than that of steel and its hardness is comparable to that of lead.

These two characteristics make it possible to produce a variety of shot suitable for firing through any shotgun choke, be it modern or traditional, whilst retaining a high stopping power and lethality to even the most robust gamebirds at longer distance.
